Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing of para 6 of the Transfer Policy dated 25.06.2019 (P-2).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 02.09.2021 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director Public Instruction (Secondary Education), Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 02.09.2021 (P-5), by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law, within a period of 02 (two) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
