Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 11.

Petitioner No.1 is a doctor, petitioner No.2 is his wife. It is stated that the petitioner No.1 was falsely implicated in case FIR No. 31 dated 19.04.2014, under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station Islamabad at the instance of the private respondents. Petitioner No.2 alongwith her nephew was falsely implicated in FIR No. 57/2014 under Section 307/336/120-B/34 IPC registered at Police Station Islamabad,

Amritsar. After detailed investigation both the FIR's were cancelled. Kallandra under Section 182 Cr.P.C. was registered against respondent No.4. The petitioners are constantly receiving threats from the private respondents. In this regard a representation Annexure P-4 has been submitted to respondent No. 2-The Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. A.G., Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or opining on the veracity of the allegations contained in the representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as raised by them in the application (P-4) and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
