Petitioner Harbhajan Lal has appeared in Court today in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court.

Mr. Ashok Giri, learned counsel for respondent No.4 has stated that respondent No.4 could not appear today in view of the fact that he is already lodged in jail in some other cases.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petition for Habeas Corpus was filed under some mistaken belief that the alleged detainee i.e respondent No.4 was under the illegal detention of the police and today he is present in the Court and has also explained that since he is the uncle of the detainee, he was informed with regard to illegal detention of respondent No.4 and that was the reason as

to why he had filed the present petition. He further submitted that the aforesaid detainee was not found in custody of anybody and, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

Mr. Ashok Giri, learned counsel for respondent No.4 who was the alleged detainee and was impleaded as a party in the present case has categorically submitted that he has no objection in case the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition in view of the fact that the petitioner was under the wrong impression that respondent No.4 has been detained by the police.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the present case, nothing survives in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
