HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.437 dated 09.12.2021 under Sections 379-A, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Gadpuri, District Palwal Haryana.

FIR was registered on the complaint of one Parveen Kumar, who stated that on 18.11.2021 at about 8:30 p.m. he was standing at bus stop of village Jaindapur. Meanwhile, four boys came there with a motorcycle and snatched mobile phone, Rs. 2,000/-, bluetooth & key of the vehicle from him and fled away.

The petitioner was arrested in another case bearing FIR No. 439 dated 11.12.2021, under Section 25 of the Arms Act. During interrogation in that case, the petitioner disclosed his involvement in the present case. The mobile phone snatched from the complainant was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The

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investigation in the case is complete. Petitioner is in custody since 12.12.2021. The complainant has been examined, however he has turned hostile. He has not identified the petitioner as being one of the persons who snatched the mobile phone and other articles.

In view of the above and the fact that the trial is unlikely to conclude in near future, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. This petition is allowed. Petitioner-Mahesh be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
