Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider his claim for appointment to the post of Clerk in pursuance of Advertisement No.05/2019 (Annexure P-5) in the ESM General (Disabled) category, alleging that the candidates, lower in merit than him having secured 29 marks have been selected and appointed. Whereas, as per the answer key uploaded on the website of respondent No.2-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, the petitioner has secured 41 marks (un-revised) in the written examination.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of his aforesaid grievance, petitioner also submitted a representation dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-9) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by the competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-9) by passing a speaking order. He also points out that earlier result was quashed by this court and later revised result was declared.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law within a period of two months from today.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
