1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.01.2019, in CWP-2755-2019.
2. A perusal of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.01.2019, reveals that CWP-2755-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 03.12.2018, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any monetary benefits, to release the same to him within three months thereafter.
3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed short reply along with copy of speaking order Annexure R/T-1, dated 26.12.2019, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 03.12.2018. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not

the same with liberty to challenge order Annexure R/T-1 dated 26.12.2019, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
