MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose of CRM-M-32202-2021 and CRM-M-37597-2021, as the issue involved in both the cases is similar and the cases emanate from the same FIR. However, the facts are being extracted from CRM-M-32202-2021.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s), in case FIR No. 0052, dated 28.07.2021, lodged under Sections 406, 498-A & 34 IPC, registered at Kheri Dorangla, District Gurdaspur (annexed as Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein would contend that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the said FIR. It is further contended that a perusal of the FIR would clearly reflect that the allegations are general in nature against them and with a specific mention only qua Malkiat Singh demanding a motorcycle and giving beatings to the complainant.

Learned counsel further submits that in compliance of the order dated 24th August, 2021 and 10th September, 2021, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Per contra, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Taranjit Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that since the petitioners have joined investigation, their further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation is not required.

Heard.

In view of above, the petitions are allowed and interim orders dated 24th August, 2021 and 10th September, 2021, are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
