Today, Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellant has been filed by Mr.Lokesh Chander Aggarwal, Advocate, which is taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of the appellant, learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹1,50,000/- (₹ One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹1,50,000/- in the name of the appellant - Ashok Sharma son of Shri Amrit Ram Sharma with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 20.10.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company.
