ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing result dated 21.05.2019 (Annexure P-6) whereby petitioner has not been declared qualified candidate to compete for the mains examination despite the fact having been secured more marks than the last candidate in his category.

2. While issuing notice of motion, following orders were passed on 29.05.2019:-

“The petitioner has participated for HCS (Ex. Br.) Preliminary examination under the ESM general category and has secured 109.25 as per his own calculation and the last selected candidate to participate in the written examination has secured 104.82 marks.

Notice of motion.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall be allowed to participate in the written examination. List on 16.10.2019.

A copy of this order be given dasti under the signature of Bench Secretary.”

3. *Apropos*, petitioner was though allowed to participate in the written main examination, but yet he did not appear in the same, and therefore, writ petition is rendered infructuous. In any case, there has been non-compliance of order dated 29.05.2019.

4. No grounds for further interference are made out. Dismissed.
