The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 10 and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners.

2. A status report dated 28.09.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Sajjan Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hodal and the same is taken on record.

3. As per the said reply, the statements of the petitioners were recorded, wherein they have stated that they are residing happily together and they have no apprehension at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 10. The copies of the statement are annexed as Annexures R1 and R-2 to the reply of the State.

The statement of father of petitioner No.1 was also recorded, wherein he has stated that he never threatened the petitioners and will not do so in future. The said statement is annexed as Annexure R-3 to the reply of the State.

4. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
