Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was working with the Department of School Education since 19.12.2018 and continued working there upto 30.01.2020, after which the petitioner joined the post of Assistant Professor, on which post the petitioner was duly selected by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission.

Learned counsel argues that the petitioner had submitted the technical resignation from the post of PGT Economics but the respondents made the petitioner to deposit one month salary, which is not envisaged in the rules as the petitioner had already given technical resignation to join another post within the State of Haryana. Learned counsel submits that the respondents are under obligation to return the petitioner one month salary, which has been deposited by the petitioner under protest, along with interest.

Learned counsel submits that further claim of the petitioner is for counting the service rendered by her in the Department of Secondary Education Haryana.

Learned counsel submits that the grievance as raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-15), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied if respondents No.2 and 4 are directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding the legal notice dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-15) filed by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to decide the legal notice dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-15) filed by the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
