The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detainee from the illegal custody of respondent No.4.

The status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police Central, Jalandhar has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the girl has now been recovered and she is not in illegal custody and is residing with the petitioner.

Mr. Shiva Khurmi, learned AAG, Punjab has submitted that it is correct that the alleged detainee, namely, Ganga (wrongly stated as

Parmila in the head note of the petition) is now residing with the petitioner and is not in illegal custody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
