SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner was issued passport dated 21.11.2008 with validity of 10 years. It expired on 20.11.2018. In the said passport his date of birth is mentioned as 20.10.1970. Thereafter, the petitioner has applied for re-issuance of his passport and has also sought correction of the date of birth. The date of birth is sought be corrected on the basis of Aadhar Card, Voter Card and PAN Card. Correction having not been done, the present writ petition has been filed.

Aadhar Card, Voter Card and PAN Card are not proofs of correct date of birth and, thus, the passport authorities were justified in refusing to re-issue the passport with corrected date of birth.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file fresh application supported by legally valid evidence of the correct date of birth.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
