1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.01.2021, in CWP-182-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 27.01.2021, reveals that CWP-182-2021, was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide the pending appeal within three months from the date of order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to notice issued to respondent No.3 on 07.09.2021, needful has been done and the appeal filed by the petitioner has been decided vide order dated 27.09.2020, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 27.09.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent No.3 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
