Through this petition, petitioners are seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents for fixing the seniority of the petitioners over and above the private respondents No. 5 to 8 as private respondents have been given seniority without having cleared the type test and have also challenged their seniority on the ground that their lien could not have been maintained in Karnal Range.

Pursuant to the notice of motion issued, counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State would submit that the grievance of the petitioners has been addressed as respondents No. 5 to 8 stands transferred back to their parent range.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition at the present moment. He however, seeks liberty to file an application for grant of monetary benefits.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Needless to say, in case, any application, seeking grant of monetary benefits, is moved by the petitioners, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
