Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the service of the petitioner has been terminated vide order dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-9), which act of the respondents is not only contrary to the direction given by the Coordinate Bench of this Court while passing order in **CWP No.15672 of 2021** titled as **Amit Kumar and others versus State of Haryana and others**, decided on 25.04.2022 but is also against the rules of natural justice as the grounds taken by the petitioner in reply to the show cause notice have not been taken into consideration at all while terminating the service of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that she has instructions to submit that impugned order dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-9) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the respondents to pass a fresh order on the objection/reply to the show cause notice filed by the petitioner and

the petitioner will be allowed to continue in service till the fresh order is passed.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that while passing the order on the reply given to the show cause notice, the grounds taken by the petitioner therein will be adverted into by giving reasons for the conclusion.
