HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the petitioner was promoted to the post Sewer Inspector his salary was not fixed in accordance with law. Learned counsel submits that the pay scale fixed for the post of Sewer Inspector was not given to the petitioner despite the fact that the petitioner discharged the duties of the said post after promotion in the year 1995 till the date he attained the age of superannuation and retired in the year 2009. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the respondents are under obligation to grant the petitioner the salary of the post of Sewer Inspector from the date he was promoted till he retired with consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the claim as being raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner with the respondents vide legal notice dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner on 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-3), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
