In the present petition, prayer of the petitioners is for the implementation of the judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-16446-2010, titled as ***“Jaswinder Singh Bedi and others Vs. State of Punjab and others”***, decided on 20.05.2013, and to further pass appropriate orders for the grant of relief, admissible to the petitioners, by the respondents.

Learned State counsel submits that though the reply is yet to be filed, but the respondents have already considered the claim of the petitioners in terms of the judgment passed in **Jaswinder Singh Bedi's case** (supra), as raised in the present petition, and appropriate orders in case of all the petitioners have already been passed by the respondents, the respective copies of which, have already been supplied to all the petitioners.

Learned State counsel further submits that except petitioner

No.1, namely Hari Chand, all the other petitioners have been found entitled for the grant of relief in terms of the judgment passed in **Jaswinder Singh Bedi's case** (supra) and they will be granted the said relief as per the orders, which have already been passed by the respondents in their respective cases, within a period of two months from today.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been not pressed any further. As petitioner No.1, namely Hari Chand, has been declined the grant of relief in terms of the judgment passed in **Jaswinder Singh Bedi's case** (supra), he will be at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy available to him for redressal of his grievances before the appropriate Forum.
