Detailed reply submitted by respondent No.2 is allowed to be taken on record.

In this case the petitioners-Kewal Singh, Amarveer Singh and Amarjit Kaur filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0021 dated 01.06.2022 under Sections 498-A, 494, 506 and 34 IPC, 1860 registered at Women Police Station, District Bathinda and all other subsequent proceedings arising out therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.06.2022.

Notice of the petition was given to the respondents and as per order dated 11.07.2022 the parties were directed to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their statement on the basis of compromise. However, for the last two dates nobody is appearing on behalf of the petitioners. The report has been received from Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda dated 01.08.2022 according to which complainant Lovepreet Kaur appeared in the Court and suffered statement

that the compromise could not materialised and she wanted to pursue the proceedings in the aforesaid FIR.

Today the respondent No.2 has again filed detailed written reply confirming the fact that there is no compromise between the parties as the petitioners did not fulfill the terms and conditions of the compromise. From the aforesaid facts, it is clear that the compromise could not materialise. Even the petitioners have stopped appearing for the last two dates and from their conduct it is clear that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the present petition.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
