The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 18.04.2021 under Sections 498-A and 323 IPC (Sections 325 and 376 IPC 1860 and Section 3(1) of SC/ST Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of order dated 12.08.2021, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Onkar Singh does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. He, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less custodial interrogation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

Since the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency and in addition, there is no likelihood of she absconding, the instant petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.08.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
