1. The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.
2. Leave granted.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. However, it is permissible to co-petitioner No. 1 to, on valid grounds, move an application seeking her exemptions from personal appearance, before the learned trial Judge concerned, and, upon the above applications being preferred before the learned trial Judge concerned, he/she may pass the appropriate orders thereons. However, the accused may not be exempted from recording their personal appearances, when their personal appearances, as such, are required for putting to them the relevant charge, and/or, when proceedings under Section 313 Cr.P.C., are to be drawn against them.
5. Moreover, the learned trial Judge concerned, is directed to, within three months from today, conclude the trial, as arises from the petition FIR.
