The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.46 dated 07.03.2022 under Sections 454, 380, 342, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 11.07.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 11.07.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 11.07.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
