The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry from some senior police officer to the rank of IPS in FIR No. 46 dated 22.5.2022 under Sections 302, 201, 34 (added later on), registered at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the son of the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and the investigation is not being conducted properly. He submitted that complaint/representation was moved to the SSP, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur Annexure P-4 and also to the DGP, Punjab vide Annexure P-6 but no action has been taken in this regard.

At this stage, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, DAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh has stated that all the complaints/applications which were moved by both the parties were

pending before SSP, Batala but an application was filed by the complainant to the Inspector General of Police, Border Range that the matter be marked to some other SSP and, therefore, the Inspector General of Police, Border Range had directed that the applications/complaints be sent to SSP, District Gurdaspur and in this way all the applications/complaints are now pending before the SSP Gurdaspur and the same will be considered in due course and as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard the learned counsels for the parties.

The prayer made in the present petition is with regard to conducting of fair and impartial inquiry from some senior police officer to the rank of IPS. However, today the learned State counsel has apprised this Court that earlier the complaints/applications of both the parties were pending before the SSP, Batala in whose jurisdiction the FIR was lodged and thereafter on an application moved to the Inspector General of Police, Border Range the same have now been transferred to SSP, Gurdaspur.

In view of the aforesaid position, no further action is required in the present case and, therefore, the present petition is, hereby, dismissed.
