HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.35 dated 12.04.2021, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 307, 186, 353 and 341 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case; that no such occurrence had taken place; that the petitioner has been in custody since 13.04.2021, and that there is no other case registered or pending against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the above-noted FIR was got registered by Manpreet Singh, Principal, Government High School, Panj Graian; that injury on the head of Santosh Rani, with a *datar*, has been attributed to the petitioner, and that left side of body of the injured has got permanently paralysed on account of the injury caused to her by the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner had caused injury on the head of Santosh Rani, Maths Teacher and that the said injury has been declared dangerous to life. Learned Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, while dismissing the bail application of the petitioner, noticed that the said injury had resulted into damage to nerves of brain and left side of her body had got permanently paralysed and she could move only on wheel chair.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, this Court does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
