The present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 30 dated 7.2.2020, under Section 20 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

After arguing for some time and realising that the present petition is not maintainable in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **Manish Jain v. Haryana State Pollution Control Board, 2021(1) AICLR 416**, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender before the court within a week and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

Dismissed as not pressed. In case the petitioner surrenders within a week and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within one day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
