Prayer in the present petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 01.07.2022 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat in case FIR No.467 dated 07.06.2022, under Sections 363, 376(2)(n), 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.2 was granted bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat by ignoring all the facts and circumstances of this case. He further submits that the petitioner i.e. prosecutrix was exploited by respondent No.2 in the misconception of the fact and hence, there was no ground for grant of bail to respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from L/SI Asha submits that the cancellation is prepared in this case and the same is likely to be filed before the Court of competent jurisdiction within

two weeks.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner, nothing survives in this petition. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedy as available to her under the law.
