LISA GILL, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has completed 12 months' continuous service and is entitled to grant of revised pension after benefit of one notional increment. However, said benefit has been erroneously denied to him. Reliance is placed upon decision dated 16.03.2022 in CWP-32598-2019, titled *Gurdev Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*.

Learned counsel submits that petitioner has been representing before the authorities in this respect and representation dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) has also been served but to no avail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts her prayer for a decision on the representation dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-2), in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Sunint Kaur, Asst. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the State does not raise any serious objection to the limited prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide representation dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-2), within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner is found entitled to any monetary benefit, it be released within the next two months.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
