Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the cases of petitioners for transfer at preferred stations according to their date of joining.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioners, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case representation dated 04.07.2022 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Secretary, School Education, Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation in accordance with law by passing

speaking order within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
