Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.146 dated 19.06.2022 registered under Sections 15, 18, 20, 21, 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police by virtue of order of interim bail dated 11.07.2022 passed by this Court.

The State counsel on instructions from HC Sewak Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial

interrogation. The State counsel further apprised this Court that the petitioner has already been found innocent as no recovery is effected.
