Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime and realizing that there is effective remedy under the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law. Further prayer is made that the minors are of one year and 4 ½ years and she will make an application for interim relief and the same be considered in a time bound manner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

There is no doubt that in the eventuality of petitioner's approaching the Court concerned with a prayer for interim relief, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

Since the main case has been withdrawn, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
