Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuing directions to the respondents for proper investigation or in alternate to hand over the investigation of FIR No.262 dated 26.07.2018 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal.

Notice of motion was issued on 31.05.2019. Learned State counsel had accepted the notice. In pursuance thereof, a short reply dated 25.07.2019 by way of affidavit of Ram Dutt, HPS, Dy. Superintendent of Police, Gharaunda, Karnal has been filed. The relevant paragraph of the said affidavit is reproduced as under:

“That the verification of the case was conducted Raj Kumar, Inspector/SHO Police Station Madhuban, Karnal who found that no wrongful gain was caused to any ineligible persons nor any loss was caused to the Gram Panchayat of village Uncha Samana. In this way, as per verification and opinion of Legal

Officer, office of S.P. Karnal, the cancellation report was written in the above said case FIR on 18.02.2019 and same was submitted before the Ld. Illaqa Magistrate, Karnal on 04.07.2019 for further proceeding.

That the investigation in the present case has been conducted thoroughly and fairly therefore it is not required to be transferred to CBI, Crime or any other Independent Agency. It is humbly submitted that the Investigating Officer and the local police have investigated the matter without any pressure or showing any undue biased to the accused/complainant. Thus the present petition deserves to be dismissed.”

In view of the said para, learned State counsel submits that this case has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to get it revived in case any cause of action still survives.
