Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 18.05.2021, under Sections 25 of the Arms Act, Sections 379-B, 392, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 411 and 201 IPC added vide order dated 01.10.2021), registered at Police Station Phase 11, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and co-accused had allegedly snatched a mobile phone, a wallet containing ₹400/- in cash and other documents from the complainant. The petitioner is in custody for over 08 months and is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 08 months, he is not involved in any other criminal case, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
