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Learned counsel for the appellants has moved an application for bringing on record the legal representatives of appellant No.2. Learned counsel for the Insurance Company states that he has no objection if the LRs of appellant No.2 are brought on record.

CM is, consequently, allowed as prayed for.

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As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,85,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel for the appellants further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1- Sudesh W/o Shri Rajesh @ Rakesh for & on behalf of all the appellants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.5,85,000/- favouring appellant No.1 – Sudesh W/o

Shri Rajesh @ Rakesh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.09.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
