VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.27 dated 22.03.2022 registered under Section 21 of the Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and Section 379 IPC at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the police within a period of 7 days and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after his surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 5 days.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application, however, does not object to the said course of action.

Keeping in view the above said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the police within a period of 7 days and in case after surrendering, the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 5 days from the date of the said application being moved.
