SANT PARKASH, J.

On 10.01.2022, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 08.09.2021 subject to his resolving the dispute with the added respondents No. 2 and 3.

Mr. Azad Singh, Advocate appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 has submitted that till date no effort has been made by the petitioner to comply with the aforesaid order.

On request of learned Counsel for the petitioner, case is adjourned to 31.01.2022 and if the matter is not tried to be settled amicably by the next date of hearing, the interim protection granted vide order dated 08.09.2021 shall automatically stand vacated.”

It is stated that the matter has not been amicably settled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner yet again seeks some more time to resolve the dispute.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case,

especially the above-said order dated 10.01.2022, no ground is made out for interference by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner is dismissed.
