The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to produce the detenue namely Sarabjit Kaur daughter of the petitioner before this Court, who as per the petitioner has been illegally and forcibly detained by respondent Nos.4 to 6.

A status report on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Fazilka, District Fazilka.

As per the status report, the alleged detenue namely Sarabjit Kaur and Gurmeet Singh S/o Naginder Singh (private respondent No.7 impleaded as son of Bhachar Singh in the present petition) filed a petition CRWP-3789-2021 titled “Sarabjeet Kaur and Another Vs. State Punjab and others” before this Court stating therein that they have married against the wishes of the family members of Sarabjit Kaur and apprehended danger to their life and liberty.

This Court vide order dated 23.04.2021 disposed of the said petition by passing the following order:-

“..without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-5 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.”

Since the alleged detenu Sarabjit Kaur is a major and has got married to Gurmeet Singh of her own wish and with her consent, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
