In respect of her grievance for 'grant of a moratorium' on repayment of the housing loan availed of by her from respondent No.3, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation dated 02.07.2022 (copy Annexure P-6), to the Regional Director, Reserve Bank of India, Sector-17, Chandigarh (respondent No.2), with learned counsel submitting that the said moratorium sought is in terms of the circulars issued by the Reserve Bank on 06.08.2020 and 05.05.2021, as have been referred to in the representation.

He submits that consequently the petition may be disposed of with a direction to the said respondent to dispose of the aforesaid representation, after duly hearing the petitioner within a specified time frame.

As to why the petitioner has come before this court within twelve days of having filed the representation is not understood; but be that as it may, without making any comment whatsoever on the actual merits of what is contended, either in the representation or even in this petition itself, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/competent authority in the Reserve Bank of India, to take a decision on the aforesaid representation within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order after hearing the petitioner.
