The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for seeking appropriate direction for fair investigation of the case in FIR No.223 dated 02.06.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 323, 324 and 34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Sonapat (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 27.02.2018. Pursuant to which reply dated 27.04.2018 by way of affidavit of D.K. Bhardwaj, IPS, Additional Superintendent of Police, Sonipat on behalf of respondents had been filed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar, submits that investigation was completed, whereafter challan was presented. She further makes a reference to para 3 of the reply on merits to state that though the person named as petitioner in the corresponding para of the petition had not been attributed any role by any person present at the spot, however, six other co-accused were arrested and challan was presented,

whereafter charges were framed and out of 21 witnesses, 4 witnesses have been examined. She therefore, submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
