The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondent No.2 to discharge its duties and claim the electricity bill regarding the units consumed by respondent No.3, who is stated to be the tenant of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 has handed over today in Court the copy of a memo No.3134 dated 20.10.2022 as per which it is intimated that the electricity bill of Rs.6,89,582/- has been deposited vide reference No.90288202. The aforesaid communication is taken on record as Mark-A.
