1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0203 dated 19.06.2022, Police Station Khol, District Rewari, under Sections 409/420 IPC.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 12.07.2022, the following order was passed:

“The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0203, dated 19.6.2022, Police Station Khol, District Rewari, under Sections 409 and 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there has been a delay of 4 years in lodging the FIR and that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. It has further been submitted that the amount allegedly embezzled has already been deposited along with interest.

Notice of motion for 8.9.2022.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation and that he is not wanted in any other case.
4. Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation and otherwise has a clean record, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 12.07.2022 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
5. It is clarified that the aforesaid order shall enure Sections 466/467/468/471/120-B/34 IPC as well, as the said offences are stated to have been added subsequently.
