1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.06.2021, in CWP-10960-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 29.06.2021, reveals that CWP-10960-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 18.12.2020, as representation of the petitioner and decide the same by passing a speaking order within one month.

3. Reply has been filed by learned AAG, Punjab. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof, states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 08.10.2021, rejecting the claim of the petitioners, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 08.10.2021, by way of

appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
