Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.184 dated 12.3.2020 initially registered under Sections 323, 452, 506, 34 IPC (subsequently added Section 313 IPC and Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC were added vide order dated 6.9.2021) at Police Station Suraj Kund, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 14.9.2020, interim order was passed in favour of the petitioner and he was directed to join the investigation. He submits that in pursuance to that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that thereafter, offence under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC were added. However, the petitioner filed CRM-29600-2020 for addition of these added offences in this petition and the same was allowed by this Court on 6.9.2021. He submits that after addition of the additional offences, the petitioner again joined the investigation and has duly complied with the terms and conditions imposed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that the petitioner has not

approached this Court with clean hands, as there are 7 other cases also filed against him, which were not brought to the notice of this Court.

Learned State counsel affirms the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation after 14.9.2020 and when the additional offences were added even thereafter, he also joined the investigation. He submits that there are 7 other cases against the petitioner as information provided to him, however, he is on bail in all those cases.

Heard.

The petitioner was granted interim protection on 14.9.2020 and thereafter he is on interim protection from the last about 1½ years. It is evident that the petitioner has joined the investigation in this case. So far as the rest of the cases are concerned, the petitioner is already on bail in those cases.

In the overall facts and circumstances, the order dated 14.9.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
