1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.03.2022, in CWP-4357-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 07.03.2022, reveals that CWP-4357-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim made in legal notice dated 20.09.2020, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the relief claimed and there was no impediment for the grant of the same, to release the same to the petitioner without any delay.

3. Pursuant to notice to respondent No.2, reply has been filed along with order Annexures R/1 and R/2. The same is taken on record.

Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on

perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to the petitioners to challenge orders Annexure R/1 and R/2, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
