**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for setting aside the order dated 27.05.2022, whereby the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were forfeited and non-bailable warrants have been issued by the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baghapurana, District Moga in case FIR No.146 dated 15.07.2021 registered under Sections 61, 1, 14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

On 20.07.2022, the following order was passed:-

*“The Counsel for the petitioner contends that on one date i.e. 27.05.2022 the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court because of which the impugned order dated 27.05.2022 has been passed. He submits that he is ready and willing to surrender before the trial Court and join the proceedings.*

*Notice of motion for 18.10.2022.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the trial court within a week*

*from today and on his surrender he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”*

Based on the aforementioned order, the petitioner surrendered before the Trial Court on 25.07.2022 and had been admitted to interim bail. The copy of the order dated 25.07.2022 is marked as 'X'.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
