The petitioner, who is appearing in person, at the very outset, submits that since the proposed amendment relates to a cause of action, which has accrued after filing of the rent petition, which was instituted on 06.02.2014, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh petition with new cause of action. It is further submitted that since the respondents are the same, he has got a new cause of action for filing the fresh eviction petition and it may be ordered that in case, he files a fresh rent petition within a period of 15 days from today, same be tagged and decided with Rent Petition No.35 of 2014.

In case the petitioner files fresh rent petition on the subsequent cause of action, District and Sessions Judge, Patiala will assign the same to the

same Court and it be tagged with aforesaid rent petition and both the petitions be decided together expeditiously preferably within a period of one year from today.

Disposed of, accordingly.
