Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.27 dated 27.4.2020 under Sections 326, 354-A, 323, 341, 506, 295-A, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR in question as is evident from a perusal of the FIR wherein no injury has been attributed to her and in fact the only allegation attributed is of raising a lalkara. Learned counsel states that pursuant to order dated 15.09.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and co-operated during the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh does not dispute the role attributed to the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and co-operated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions states that the petitioner is
