ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Vide order dated 27.08.2021, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.08.2021, the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation.

3. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel. However, learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant have opposed the bail. They further submit that in case this Court is inclined to give the bail to the petitioner then it should be subject to the strict and stringent conditions. Moreover, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not handed over his mobile phone.

4. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.

5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 27.08.2021, is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as mentioned hereinafter:-

- i) that the petitioner shall remain present in the concerned police Station on 07.05.2022 and join investigation.

ii) that Given the nature of allegations and the other circumstances peculiar to this case, the appellants shall surrender all weapons, firearms, ammunition, if any, along with the arms license to the concerned authority within ten days from today and inform the Investigator about the compliance. However, subject to the Indian Arms Act, 1959, the appellants shall be entitled to renew and take it back in case of acquittal in this case.

iii) Within 10 days, the petitioner shall mention details of all assets, held either individually or jointly, including bank balances, fixed deposits, DEMAT accounts, to the Investigator and its copy to the complainant/victim(s).

Failure to comply with the aforementioned any of the conditions shall *ipso facto* result in the cancellation of bail granted to the petitioner.

Pending application, if any, stands cancel.
