The petitioner applied for issuance of passport, but the file was closed in September, 2015 due to adverse police verification report.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an FIR was registered against the petitioner in the year 1990, but the same has been closed in the year 1991. Thus, refusal to issue the passport is not justified.

It is also submitted that in the objections raised in the year 2015, no details of any criminal case have been mentioned.

The file was closed way-back in the year 2015 and thus, this writ petition is liable to be dismissed on the ground of delay and laches.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file a fresh application alongwith necessary particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
