Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.106 dated 24.07.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station City Morinda, Rupnagar (Punjab).

By virtue of the order dated 13.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Salender Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However, the same remains unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the fact that the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre but the mediation remained unsuccessful. He submits that the recovery is yet to be effected from the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 13.08.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
