This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.181 dated 09.08.2019 registered under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short “NDPS Act”), however, Section 29 of NDPS Act, was added later on, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1). The first petition (CRM-M-9081 of 2021) preferred by the petitioner seeking grant of regular bail was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh petition with better particulars, vide order dated 19.07.2021.

Custody certificate dated 14.03.2022 and status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sultanpur Lodhi, Kapurthala, have been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which are taken on record.

State counsel has invited the attention of this Court to para 11 of the affidavit, wherein, the details of other cases pending against the petitioner have been given and the same is reproduced as under:-
